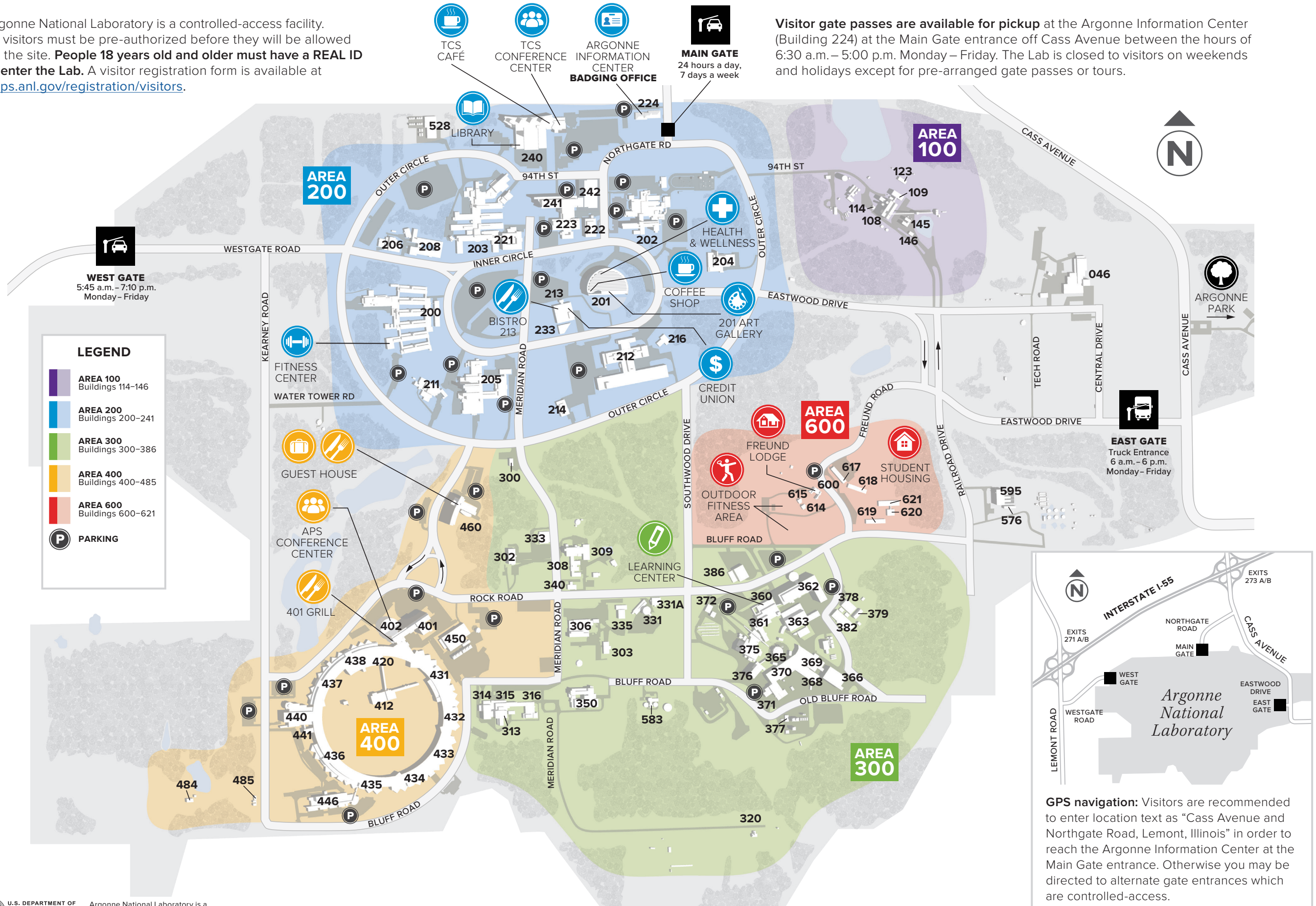


Getting Around Campus

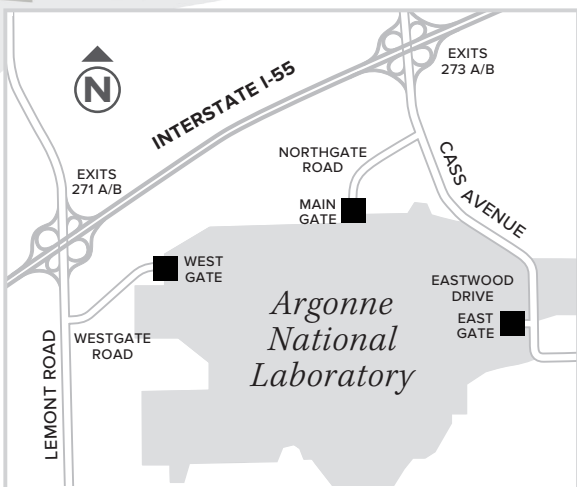
Argonne National Laboratory is a controlled-access facility. All visitors must be pre-authorized before they will be allowed on the site. **People 18 years old and older must have a REAL ID to enter the Lab.** A visitor registration form is available at apps.anl.gov/registration/visitors.

Visitor gate passes are available for pickup at the Argonne Information Center (Building 224) at the Main Gate entrance off Cass Avenue between the hours of 6:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Monday – Friday. The Lab is closed to visitors on weekends and holidays except for pre-arranged gate passes or tours.
