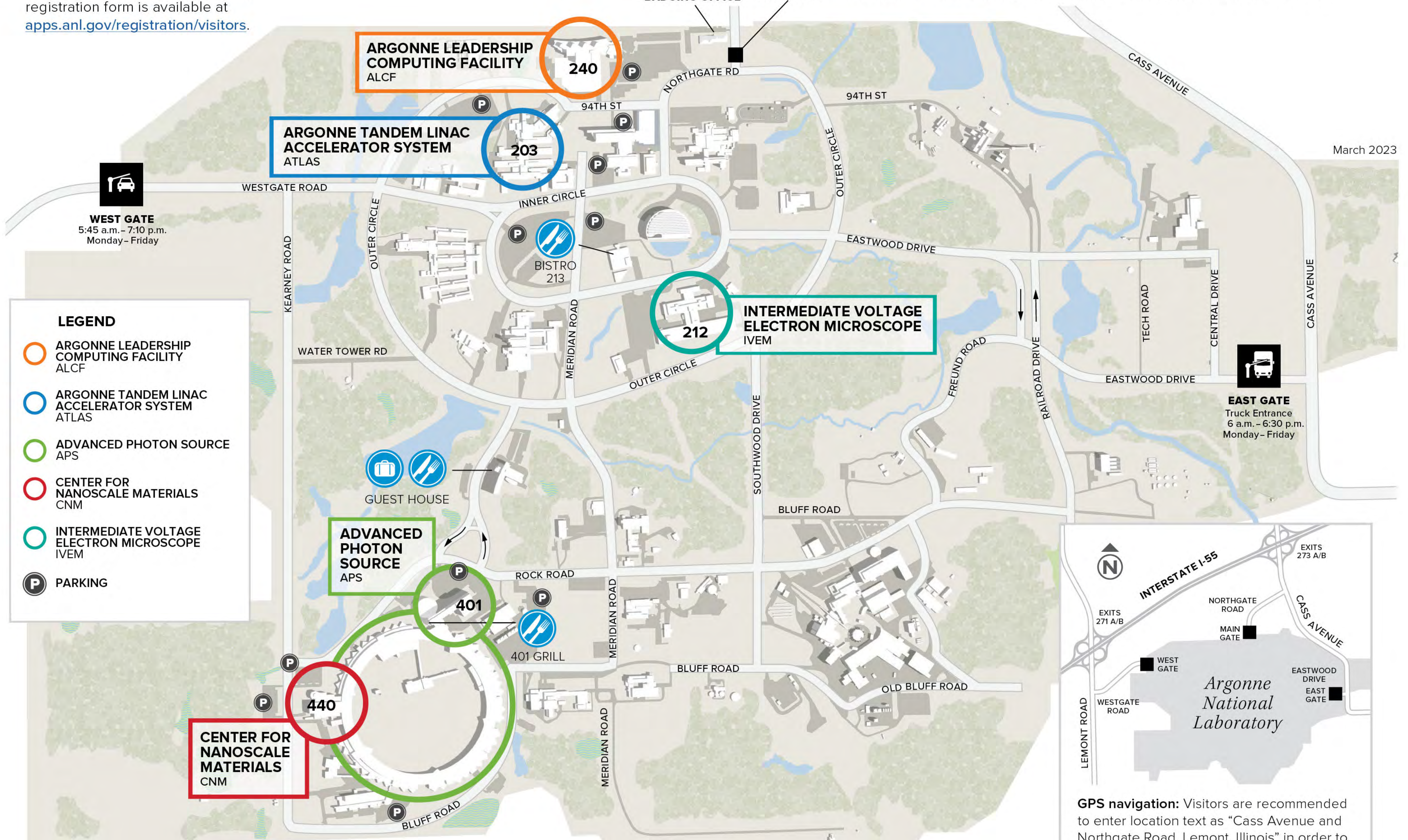


# National User Facilities

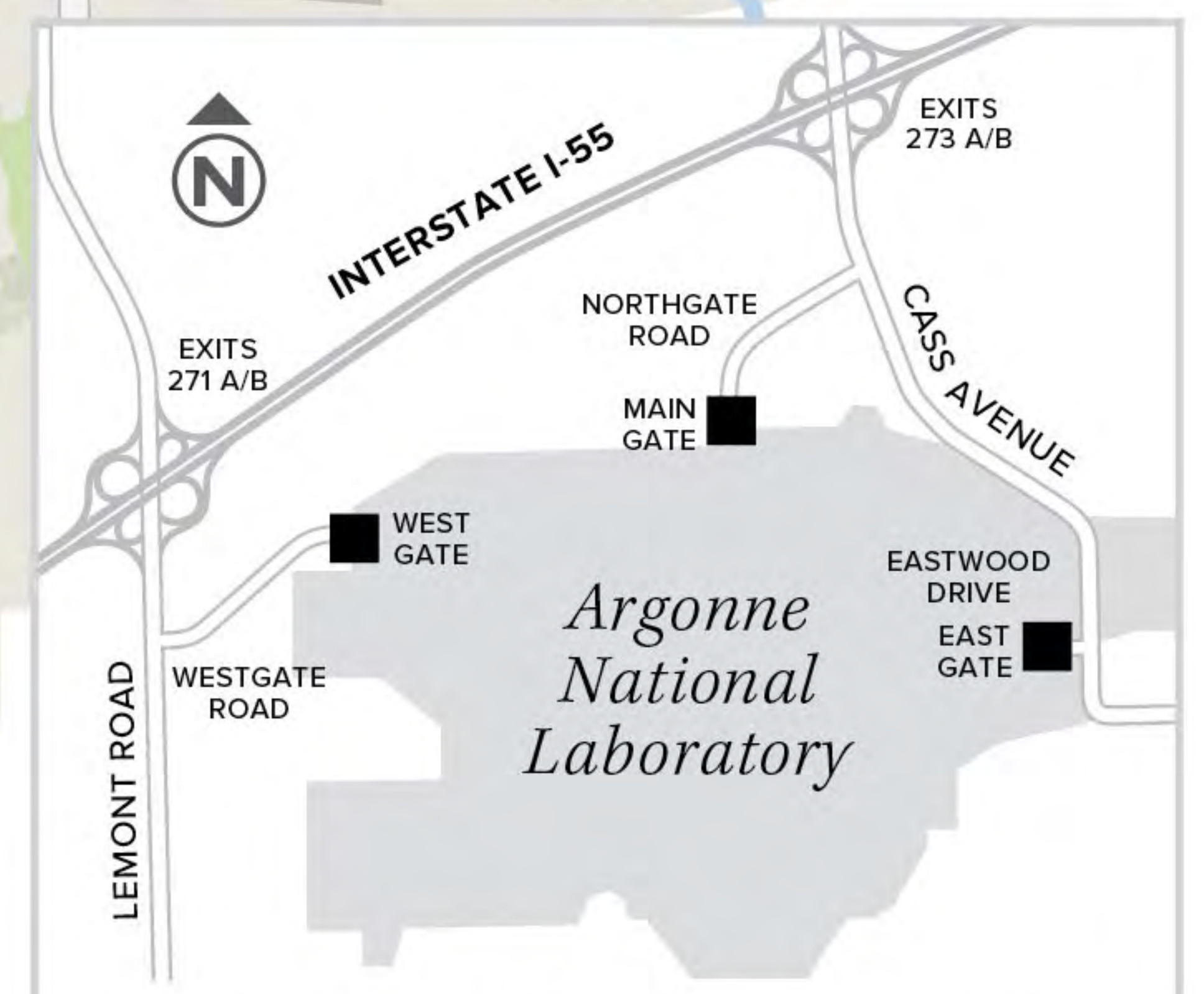
Argonne National Laboratory is a controlled-access facility. All visitors must be pre-authorized before they will be allowed on the site. A visitor registration form is available at [apps.anl.gov/registration/visitors](https://apps.anl.gov/registration/visitors).

Visitor gate passes are available for pickup at Argonne's Visitor Information Center (Building 224) at the Main Gate entrance off Cass Avenue between the hours of 6:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Monday – Friday. The lab is closed to visitors on weekends and holidays except for pre-arranged gate passes or tours.
